Community Garden License Agreement

1. This agreement is between John Weston Sr. Memorial Food Garden, Inc and _____ for the 2018 season. (April 1 - Oct 31)
2. The purpose of this agreement is to provide garden plots for public use. Each plot will be 16' x 4', and are prepared for planting. The rental fee for a season is \$50.00 (fifty dollars). Additional plots will be \$25.00, \$10.00 for a third, if available. Fees may be negotiated under certain circumstances. Each lessee will provide his/her own seed, tools and fertilizer.
3. **Each garden plot must contribute 20% (twenty percent) of its produce to our organization, which we will distribute to our local food pantries.**
4. If your rented garden plot is left unattended for two (2) weeks without prior arrangements to have it taken care of, garden staff will take over the management of the plot, with all produce to be used as donations, and no money will be refunded
5. No plot can be gardened until payment of fees and a signed agreement is received and approved.
6. Each gardener agrees to use the plot at his/her own risk and agrees to hold John Weston St. Memorial Food Garden, Inc. harmless of any injury or damage.
7. This license may be revoked by John Weston Sr. Memorial Food Garden, Inc. at any time.

John Weston Sr. Memorial Food Garden Rules and Regulations

1. Produce and flowers from these gardens is for family use and donations, not to be sold commercially
2. Growing illegal and poisonous plants is prohibited
3. If your rented garden plot is left unattended for two (2) weeks without prior arrangements to have it taken care of, garden staff will take over the management of the plot, with all produce to be used as donations, and no money will be refunded
4. No permanent structures allowed
5. Each gardener must comply fully with all federal and state laws and regulations regarding the use of pesticides and chemicals
6. Water must be conserved! Be sure all faucets are turned off after watering. Watering must be done before 11am and after 3pm to avoid evaporation
7. Should you decide to use a soaker hose, it must be checked on daily. Garden staff reserves the right to turn off any watering system that is left on for extended periods of time
8. Each gardener must comply fully with all federal and state laws and regulations
9. Each gardener must maintain a neat garden, keeping plots and surrounding paths free from overgrown weeds, insect pests, and diseases
10. Gardeners and volunteers are not allowed to walk on or step in garden beds
11. All trash must be deposited into barrels; all plant waste must be put in compost piles
12. Be considerate to your neighbors. Do not plant sprawling or tall crops in locations that might interfere or shade other plots. Harvest only from your assigned plots unless you have permission to do so from other members
13. Children are welcome and encouraged to participate but must be supervised at all times
14. Pets are not allowed
15. All garden participants are required to stay in the garden greenspace only
